Eligibility

Your program must include the following:

- An intervention conducted within the past 10 years
- An intervention with English-language materials that practitioners can use in a US community or clinical setting
- Evidence that is demonstrated in at least one study using an experimental or quasi-experimental design
- One or more positive behavioral or psychosocial outcomes ($p \leq 0.05$, or at least 95% confidence interval) among individuals, communities, or populations
- Findings published in a peer-reviewed journal
