


## **Clinical Points**

- **Prostate:** Localized prostate carcinomas frequently are asymptomatic and diagnosis is suspected during a routine rectal exam. Colonoscopy has been found to be useful Colon: in making a differential diagnosis. **Breast:** Incidence increases with age. Screening should include clinical breast exam. instructing patients in BSE, and mammography for women over age 50. Cough, hemoptysis, wheeze and stidor, Lung: pneumonitis dyspnea from obstruction initial symptoms. Patients with all histologic types of cancer sometimes had microscopic residual disease. Ask your patient if they smoke and advise them 'to
- **Cervical:** Third most frequent female cancer. Viral infection may play important role in development of disease. Purpose of cytologic screening (Pap Smear) is to prevent invasive cervical cancer.
